What is your favorite thing about Parkway?

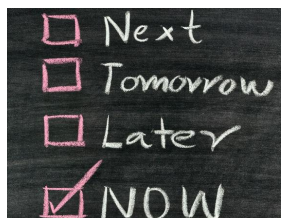

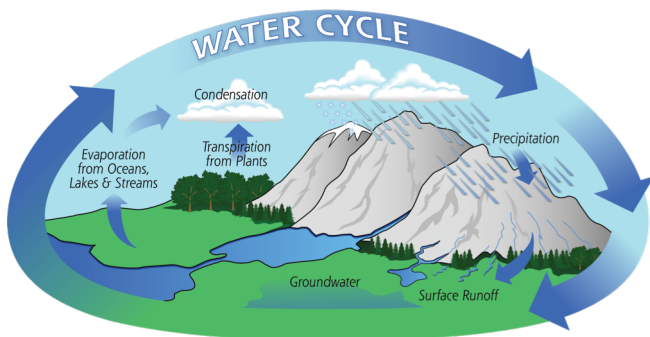


Art Corner
